### **How the Auction Works...**

When you attend the Auction as a prospective buyer, sale books will be available, listing all the animals in order of sale, their weights and owners. As each animal is led onto the auction block, the Auctioneer will ask for bids in cents per pound. If you wish to bid on the animal, raise your hand, whether you buy or not, your bidding will help the sale. If you need help bidding, ask one of the ring assistants for help. The bidding will continue until a high bid is reached, the highest bidder gets the animal.

Auction time will be 9:00 am. In order to plan your arrival we provide the sale order:

- 1) Lambs
- 2) Goats
- 3) Rabbits, Turkeys, and Chickens
- 4) Beef
- 5) Pigs

### **Why You Should Buy...**

Your purchase will help support an educational program. These 4-H and FFA members are learning to produce food for your table. They are also learning how to be in business for themselves. But at their age, their business is on a small scale and their costs are higher than commercial feed lot producers. Help them achieve success and insure continued food production by supporting them now. The price you pay today encourages youth participation and is a small investment in the future of America.

### **After Purchasing An Animal...**

Sign for your purchase and indicate your instructions for the disposition of your animal(s). Please make arrangements for the processing of your animal(s) with one of the following:

- A local meat market for cutting and wrapping
- Live Pickup
- If you do not want the animal for your personal use, you may consign for the resale at market prices. You will pay bid price, less resale value. Another option is donating your purchase to the Salvation Army or Napa Food Bank.
- Please note:

**All Champion and Reserve Champion animals are terminal. Live pick up may not be selected.**

## **Napa Salvation Army Donations**

The Salvation Army in Napa feeds a hot lunch to approximately 100 hungry people every weekday and an evening meal for another 65 people staying in the homeless shelter. It takes about 60 pounds of meat each day for these meals. **Meat donations are difficult to obtain.**

Beef, pork, lamb, or goat would really assist in stretching the daily meals. The local Salvation Army operates with a minimum staff and provides support to the most needed in Napa including families and the elderly who need emergency food, clothing, or emotional support. Donating an animal purchased at the Junior Livestock Auction would directly benefit the local community.
